Send entries to the Test Secretary. Make checks payable to “**Southern Minnesota NAVHDA**”. No entry is posted until the Secretary receives your completed entry form and check (See Entries below).

Eligibility

All dogs entered in NAVHDA tests must be NAVHDA registered. The single registration fee is \$15.00. Partial registration is available for dogs that cannot provide a recognized three-generation pedigree in time for a test. The partial registration fee is \$15.00. If your dog is not NAVHDA registered prior to a test, you may enclose the dog’s pedigree and the registration fee with your test entry. Dogs are eligible for Natural Ability testing up to and including the day they reach 16 months of age. Dogs over 16 months of age may be run for evaluation and only if space is available. No prize classification can be awarded a dog run for evaluation regardless of the score attained.

Entries

Test entries are limited and will be taken on a first come, first served basis subject to the rules of eligibility stated above. A test entry is a completed Official 2008 Test Entry Form (found at www.navhda.com) accompanied by the correct test entry fee (see above). Non-NAVHDA members will be sent a copy of the test rules upon receipt of a completed test entry. No entries will be accepted after June 1st.

In the event that a handler withdraws 14 or more days before a test for medical reasons, 75% of the entry fee will be refunded if the handler produces a letter from a physician and/or veterinarian stating that a handler or dog should not participate in the test for medical reasons. **Under no other circumstances will any refunds be made.**
